The 2011 *Images from a Glass Eye* International Juried Photography Show announced the Best of Show winner on Friday August 26, 2011 at the Big Picture in Red Bluff. The \$1,000 award for Best of Show was awarded to **Stephanie Luke** of Cottonwood, CA for her photo entitled "Denouement." Ms. Luke also won Best of Show in 2010.

Northern California professional photographers and photography educators Susan and Neil Silverman judged the 260 entries. "Entries were judged on the 12 criteria of the Professional Photographers of America including technical excellence, lighting, attention to detail, story telling, impact and creativity, plus extra criteria such as being *out of the box*," said Susan Silverman. Entries were received from as far away as New York, Canada and China.

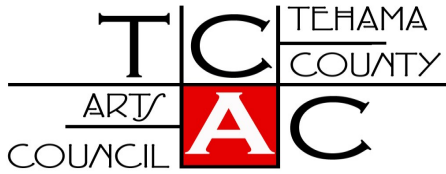
